

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE VIOLATIONS

FOR MINORS

- ◆ Purchase ◆ Attempt to Purchase ◆
- ◆ Possession ◆ Consumption ◆
- ◆ Misrepresentation of Age ◆
- ◆ Public Intoxication by Minor ◆

Penalties

First Offense

Class C misdemeanor. Up to \$500 fine.
Alcohol awareness course.
8-12 hours community service.
30-day driver's license suspension or denial.

Second Offense

Class C misdemeanor. Up to \$500 fine.
Possible alcohol awareness course.
20-40 hours community service.
60-day driver's license suspension or denial.

Third Offense (Under 17)

180-day driver's license suspension or denial.
Juvenile Court: Child in need of supervision, or
Criminal Court: Adjudicated as an adult.

Third Offense (17 or Older)

Class B misdemeanor. \$250 to \$2,000 fine and/or
confinement in jail up to 180 days.
Possible alcohol awareness course.
180-day driver's license suspension or denial.





TOLERANCE

◆While Driving◆

It is illegal for a minor to drive while having *any* detectable amount of alcohol in the minor's system.

Penalties

First Offense

Class C misdemeanor. Up to \$500 fine.
Alcohol awareness course.
20-40 hours community service.
60-day driver's license suspension.
30-day ineligibility for occupational license.

Second Offense

Class C misdemeanor. Up to \$500 fine.
Alcohol awareness course.
40-60 hours community service.
120-day driver's license suspension.
Ineligible for occupational license for 90 days.

Third Offense (Under 17)

180-day driver's license suspension.
Ineligible for occupational license.
Juvenile Court: Delinquent conduct or Adult Criminal Court.

Third Offense (17 or Older)

Class B misdemeanor. \$500 to \$2,000 fine and/or confinement in jail up to 180 days.
180-day driver's license suspension.
Ineligible for occupational license.
