ORDINANCE NO. 111

An ordinance offering a reward to anyone furnishing information leading to the arrest and conviction of person or persons committing the crime of arson in the city limits of Tom Bean.

Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Tom Bean;

The City of Tom Bean, Texas hereby offers a reward of TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) to anyone who secures and furnishes information necessary to and which results in the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who commit the crime of arson within the corporate city limits of said city of Tom Bean, Texas. This reward is a standing offer, and shall be paid out of the General fund of the City of Tom Bean.

Whereas public safety demands the immediate passage of this ordinance, therefore an emergency exists demanding the suspension of the rules requiring three separate readings, that rule is suspended and this ordinance is approved on its first reading.
