

CITY OF TOM BEAN

ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OPERATION OF VEHICLES WITHOUT A PROPER MUFFLER, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$200.00) DOLLARS.

WHEREAS, there is a need for governing the use of vehicles without a proper muffler in the City of Tom Bean, Texas, and

WHEREAS, to eliminate disturbing the peace of the citizens of the City of Tom Bean, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOM BEAN:

SECTION 1. Mufflers for engines.

It shall be unlawful to discharge into the open air within the limits of the City of Tom Bean, whether upon public or private property the exhaust of any steam engine, stationary engine, motor vehicle or motor boat engine, except through a muffler or other device that will prevent loud or excessive noise therefrom and any person operating such steam engine, stationary internal-combustion engine, motor vehicle or motor boat engine without such a device or causing loud and excessive noise shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$200.00) DOLLARS.


SECTION 2. Penalties.

The violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed an offense and punishable by fine not to exceed \$200.00, and each violation thereof shall be, and the same is hereby, deemed to be a distinct and separate offense and punishable as such.

SECTION 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.


All existing ordinances of the City of Tom Bean, Texas, are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance.
