

ORDINANCE NO. 95-01

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MANDATORY USAGE OF WATER SYSTEM AND SEWER SYSTEM WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TOM BEAN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$200.00 FOR VIOLATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOM BEAN:

SECTION 1: Mandatory Usage

Any owner, agent or occupant of any property located within the city limits and within one hundred (100) feet of any water line or sewer line already constructed or which may hereafter be constructed by the City of Tom Bean, shall be required to connect their water systems and sewer systems to the City of Tom Bean system.

SECTION 2: Private Water and Sewer Service

No person, firm or corporation shall ever engage in the production, transportation or distribution of water or sewer service within the City of Tom Bean, nor within its extraterritorial jurisdiction except as permitted by the City Council of the City of Tom Bean.

SECTION 3: Severability

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, changes and phrases are separable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: Penalty


Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$200.00.

SECTION 5: Emergency


Whereas, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, good government, public safety and necessity that requires this ordinance to become effective at once, therefore, upon passage of this ordinance by a vote of the council,

it shall be effective from and after the date of its passage and publication.
