### **RESOLUTION NO.2008-11**

#### **EXCESSIVE FORCE RESOLUTION**

A resolution establishing rules and regulations regarding the use of excessive force during nonviolent civil rights demonstrations, including physically barring entrance to a facility or location which is the subject of such demonstrations, and providing penalties for violations thereof: In the following City of Tom Bean, County of Grayson, Texas, as follows:

#### **ARTICLE I**

##### **Section 1:**

It is the policy of the City of Tom Bean to prohibit the use of excessive force by the law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individual engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations. The city also prohibits the physical barring of any entrance to, or exit from, such a facility within its jurisdiction.

#### **ARTICLE II**

##### **Section 1:**

It is the policy of the city to enforce this policy to the full extent allowed by law.

#### **ARTICLE III**
